Dr. Dennis, in 1977, starting performing laser surgery at Johns Hopkins Hospital. He was the first in Atlanta, Georgia to perform an Endoscopic Co2 Laser hemilaryngectomy for the treatment of Laryngeal Cancer in 1980.

Dr. Dennis, the first in the world to perform Endoscopic Co2 Laser Cordotomy for the successful rehabilitation of bilateral vocal cord paralysis.

First to invent the instrumentation and successfully perform bloodless Bipolar Submucosal Nasal Turbinate Coagulation for the relief of nasal airway obstruction.
